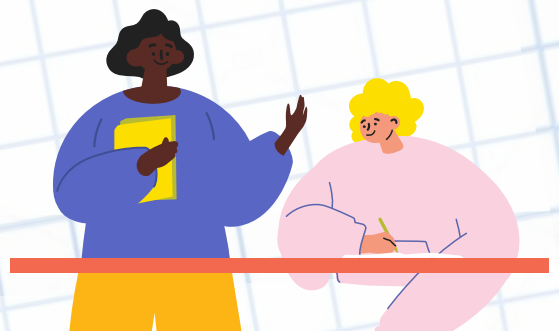


Let's Talk About... Education

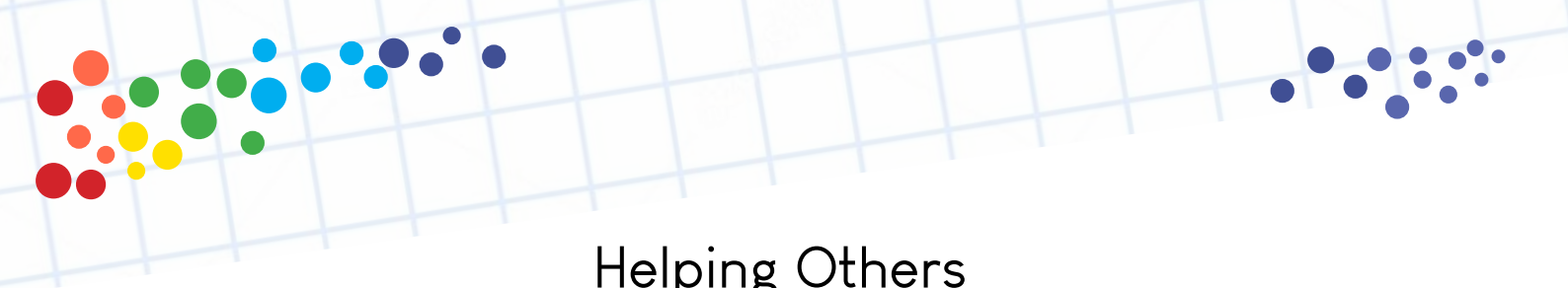
