I refer to the Australian Human Rights Commission decision dated 3 May 2018 in relation to Transport for NSW's application for a temporary exemption from compliance with Section 2.1 Unhindered Passage and Section 2.2 Continuous Accessibility under the *Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (Cth)* (Transport Standards) for the land side components of Birchgrove ferry wharf.

Following the decision of the Commission, Transport for NSW has engaged with the Inner West Council in the development of suitable options that meet requirements under the Transport Standards.

In accordance to Section 2.1 of the decision, Transport for NSW wishes to inform the Commission that a further period of 3 months is required to continue discussions with the Inner West Council to reach agreement on a compliant solution.

Due to the Christmas period, the Inner West Council has informed Transport for NSW that a determination on options presented may not be reached until February 2019.

Transport for NSW understands that this may be published and publicly available as part of the exemption process.
