I was sexually assulted by a senior management colleague at a staff function. There were witnesses all eveing to his repeated verbal sexual harassment and there was one witness to the assult. He said he needed to show me what a real man was so he could 'unlesbian' me. I reported the assult to the police the next day once I had begun to come to terms with what had happened. I was frightened and felt ashamed to speek about it to anyone. I was alsked by police if I would be able to ascertain witness statments as it would strengthen my case. Witnesses claim to "not remember" anything happening as they were scared reporting it would result in loss of emplyment. At that stage I didnt take the police report any futher. I reported it to my HR manager at work the next day and was offered money to keep guiet and not go to the police. I didn't accept any money from the company and instead tendered my resignation as I felt unsafe and unsupported. My two weeks notice was insanely trying, despite asking management to work in areas removed from my perpetrator, I was forced to work along side him where he continued to make sexual comments. This was reported and I told not to worry as i had only a short time left. It took me a month or more to tell my partner at the time what had happened. It took me 18 months to tell any family. Still to this day I feel ashamed of what happened and have not taken the matter any futher legally.
